



NIELSEN KELLERMAN (NZ) MASTERS REGATTA LAKE KARAPIRO – SATURDAY 13th MAY 2023 (With the Assistance of K.R.I.)

REGATTA RULES OF RACING AND CONDITIONS

<u>SAFETY BRIEFING at 8.00 a.m -</u> <u>A Club Representative must attend the Safety Briefing</u> <u>Racing will begin at 9.00 a.m.</u>

1. <u>Generally</u>: The Regatta shall be conducted in accordance with the NZRA Rules of Racing 2021 (Rule 6.1), and shall be governed by applicable Articles of the Constitution of the New Zealand Rowing Association Inc. Further: this regatta shall be conducted in accordance with the Rowing NZ Water Safety Code and the Rowing New Zealand Competition Safety Code (Rule 6.2), together with the Karapiro Rowing Inc. Safety Plan, of which the contents and intent take precedent over all other documents.

2. <u>Regatta Entry</u>: Will only be via rowIT <u>http:/rowit.nz/akmm2023/entry</u>

Fees :

Legion Member - \$30 per rower.

Non Legion Member - \$55 per rower.

Coxswain Only (must be a non-rower) – No Charge.

The Legion will invoice each Club for the Legion regatta fees.

5. Rowing NZ Competitors' licences - not required for this regatta.

3.<u>Masters' Classification</u>: The age of a rower in a masters rowing event shall be their age as at 31st December 2023.

The crew age categories are:

- A. Minimum age: 27 years
- B. Average age: 36 years or more
- C. Average age: 43 years or more
- **D.** Average age: 50 years or more
- E. Average age: 55 years or more
- F. Average age: 60 years or more
- G. Average age: 65 years or more
- H. Average age: 70 years or more

- I. Average age: 75 years or more
- J. Average age: 80 years or more
- K. Average age: 85 years or more

Age categories do not apply to coxswains of masters' crews.

4.<u>Where a race contains crews of mixed grades</u>, a handicap may be imposed on the younger graded crews – at the Starter's discretion.

Each competitor shall be responsible for his/her own health and fitness.

Every rower must be able to prove his/her age with the presentation of an official document (Driver's Licence, etc.), if required.

The Age Category of a Masters' crew must be calculated by the average age of the crew.

All Age Groups, as listed, will be catered for at this Masters' Regatta.

Coxed Boats can enter in a Coxless Event. A handicapping system may apply.

<u>All Mixed masters, and Novice Masters events</u>, <u>as well as the final two races on the pro-</u> gramme – Women's Eight and Men's Eight are Open events.

Open Classification : For an <u>Open Event</u> – Age groupings do not apply.

Novice Masters Events For this regatta only, are for anybody who has not competed in a race prior to 1st June 2022. This grade expands on Novice Grade (anybody who only takes up rowing after Maadi 2023) to also include those Masters who only took up rowing since last year's regatta.

5. School Parent Classification: A School Parent rower is a rower of any status -

Crews can be made up of <u>novices and experienced rowers.</u> All rowers in this classification must have had a child attend the school they are representing. An equal number of men and women must be in each crew. Multiple crews from each school may be entered. Requirements of School Parent events must be observed.

N.B. School Parent Rowers who are **novices** are only eligible to enter Events **4.and 5**. - Novice Masters Mens & Womens 4x+; Event **17**. – Mixed Masters 8+; and/or Events **27**. **& 28**. - Novice Masters 4+ events. If they are all Novices and School Parents, they cannot enter both events **16 & 17** – they must choose one or the other.

6.<u>Composite Crew Entries</u> : <u>Members from different Clubs are permitted to submit a composite</u> crew entry in any event (including for doubles and/or pairs), and any such mixed crews must compete in their registered Club colours.

N.B. <u>No individual athlete is permitted to race for a different club without having previously made a composite entry for each such race.</u>

<u>Mixed Crews Events</u>: A crew participating in a mixed event must be made up of an equal number of Male and Female members.

Coxswains: Coxswains MUST wear fitted non-inflatable life jackets. The <u>minimum</u> weight for coxswains is 55 kgs. Coxswains may be of either gender.

<u>Races</u>: Depending on the level of entries for an event, some events may have to be combined into a single race.

Bow Numbers : Each crew is required to carry an identifying bow number.

Numbers will be provided by the regatta organizers.

<u>A Handicapping System: Will be used at the Starter's discretion. Where a race is handicapped, there will only be one winner's medal awarded.</u>

<u>Previous International Competitor</u>: An International rower (who may be eligible to compete as a Masters rower due to his or her current age), shall be ineligible to race at this regatta for a period of 2 consecutive years after their last. International competition.

7. <u>Late entries</u> : <u>No late entries will be accepted after the close-off date</u>, and <u>No entries will be accepted during the regatta.</u>

<u>Crew Changes</u>: Are permitted, but <u>must be made via Regatta Control</u> - <u>at the Tower or</u> <u>Online via the rowIT online (email) option</u> – These changes can be made up to One Hour before the published race start time. The substituted rower must be the same gender as the original rower, and the average age of the crew in events that are not Open events, CANNOT be a younger age category than the original crew.

<u>Any crew changes required due to Medical Issues</u>: Must have been made at least <u>one hour</u> prior to the start of that event, and the substituted rower must be the same gender and the same age (or older).

8, <u>Course Description</u>: All races will be 1000 metres in length, and over a buoyed 7 wire, 6 lane, straight course with an aligned start. (Where boat holders are available, there will be held starts). The water for all intents and purposes is to be considered as still and without flow.

Lane 1 shall be closest to the Judges Tower.

"Exclusion of all tort liability of whatsoever kind" "The Legion of Rowers (Inc) reminds Rowing Clubs and rowers participating in this Legion Masters Regatta, that while every care will be taken by the Regatta Officials to ensure that the Regatta is conducted safely and efficiently and in accordance with the rules of racing established by the New Zealand Rowing Association Inc. and/ or amended by the Legion of Rowers (Inc). it is the responsibility of the Clubs to ensure that rules are complied with, and of Rowers to comply with them to ensure safe Rowing activity". "

"Further, it is a condition of participation in this Regatta that all participants accept and note that no liability either in tort of any other nature whatsoever is accepted by or will attach to the New Zealand Rowing Association, Karapiro Rowing Incorporated, Waikato Rowing Assoc. or the Legion of Rowers Inc. for any harm, damage, loss, costs, expenses, inconvenience, interference of whatever nature and whatever kind including any damage to equipment or injury to persons of whatever nature incurred in the course of or in connection with in any way related to the Regatta regardless of whether any error or omission, wrong doing, oversight, negligence or other tort whatsoever on the part of a Regatta official or other person may be established."
