<p>KRI Memorial Regatta 12th – 13th November 2022</p> <p>Regatta Format: Two-day event consisting of two single day regattas. The same race programme will be used for each day.</p> <p>Entry entities: Clubs or Schools</p> <p>Clubs or Schools do not have to enter both days but may choose to race one day only Clubs or Schools that wish to attend the regatta for both days may enter different crews and events each day.</p> <p>General entry limits: Each rower is limited to four events (before supplementaries). Each rower is restricted to two small boats per rower (pairs excluded) No per event restrictions</p> <p>Supplementary Entries: Will be open to fill vacant lanes. Entry limits may be raised depending on entries.</p> <p>Progression system: Not applicable as the racing is in divisions.</p> <p>If there are more entrants than lanes available, the event shall be run in divisions. To assist with allocation into divisions, entrants should self-seed their crews by crew number. The best crew should be seeded #1. KRI Club Regatta

26th – 27th November 2022

Regatta Format:

A two-day regatta, with heats raced on day one and finals raced on day two.

Entry entities:

Clubs or Schools

General entry limits:

Each rower is limited to four events (before supplementaries).

Each rower is restricted to two small boats per rower (pairs excluded)

No per event restrictions

Supplementary Entries:

Will be open to fill vacant lanes.

Entry limits may be raised depending on entries.

Progression system:

Standard Karapiro Rowing progression system as programmed in RP7.

Qualification System:

a. Entries into this regatta are to Finals only.

b. In the case of eight or less entries:

- i. a preliminary heat may be held at the absolute discretion of the Regatta Controller after considering the ability to complete the regatta in the time allotted.
- ii. If the situation arises that preliminary heats have been scheduled, and the regatta runs behind time, the preliminary heats shall be removed from the racing schedule. *[Feedback from Associations noted: preference is for preliminary heats to go ahead]*

c. In the event where there are more entries than places in the Final, a qualification system shall be used to determine the Finalists for the Finals.

d. The Qualification system will be a system based on heat and/or semi-final placings and in some cases based partially on times.

e. Time trials may be used to make up time should the regatta be severely delayed for any reason and cannot be completed using the published progression system.

f. Time Trials shall be used in the situation where there are more than 64 entries in an event to determine the qualifiers for 4 heats.

KRI Christmas Regatta 16th – 18th December 2022

Regatta Format:

Is a three-day regatta, with heats for the first day; heats and finals on Saturday; and finals Sunday.

Only age group heats are run on Friday. Saturday is a mixture of age group heats; age group finals; ability heats. Remaining finals on Sunday.

Entry entities:

Clubs or Schools

General entry limits:

Each rower is limited to three events (before supplementaries). Each rower is restricted to two small boats per rower (pairs excluded)

All singles and doubles events are restricted to two entries per entry entity (pairs excluded)(doesn't apply to Prem + Senior Events).

Supplementary Entries:

Will be open to fill vacant lanes.
Entry limits may be raised.

Qualification System:

KRI will endeavour to provide guidance in advance of the regatta to assist coaches with their entries (what age group heats we would expect to race on Friday, for example)

North Island Rowing Championships 28th – 30th January 2023

Regatta Dates: Saturday 28 - Monday 30 January 2023

Regatta Format: The regatta is a three-day ability focussed regatta.

Generally: heats on Saturday and Sunday; Finals Monday. **Note:** We anticipate not being able to run semi finals if the number of entries is comparable to previous years.

Entry entities:

Clubs or Schools

General entry limits:

Each rower is limited to three events (before supplementaries). Each rower is restricted to two small boats per rower (pairs excluded)

All singles and doubles events are restricted to TWO entries per Club (pairs excluded) (doesn't apply to Prem + Senior Events).

All singles and doubles events are restricted to ONE entry per School (pairs excluded) (doesn't apply to Prem + Senior Events); i.e., there are different limits depending on whether you enter as School or Club.

Club entry entity extension in effect: Clubs are permitted to enter an additional one crew for each of their affiliated Schools. Must be entered using RowITs dual-entity recognition feature. The entry limit extension for one school cannot be transferred to another school or the club. If more than one dual-entity recognition crew is entered for a school, the additional crews will count as club crews and towards the club limit.

Supplementary Entries:

Will be open to fill vacant lanes.
Entry limits will be raised.

Qualification System:

Refer to conditions

IMPORTANT NOTE: We would like to emphasise that this regatta format is new, and we are pushing ahead to ensure we are aligned with the expectation of our shareholders - the North Island Associations. Please bear with us - it is very difficult to forecast how many entries we will get for each event, so the event restrictions need to be as they are initially.

If we find that, despite the entry restrictions above, the regatta is oversubscribed (i.e., not possible to complete in 3 days) then there will need to be some way of rejecting entries. This would be a last resort. Further detail will be provided in the Regatta Conditions.
